

WFC / ASTROSOCCKER 4 U LTD (04689564) – Insolvency Disturbance Poster

Factual summary for record-keeping and regulator review • Date: 22 April 2026

What this poster covers

A concise summary of the alleged disruption pattern involving Mark Coote and Mark Endersby (directors of Astrosoccer 4 U Ltd) and the downstream disturbance to insolvency professionals and creditors. This is a summary only—supporting material is contained in the exhibit packs and correspondence.

Key public record anchors

- **Astrosoccer 4 U Ltd** is recorded at Companies House as being in insolvency from **administration starting 12 Sep 2017** and later **creditors' voluntary liquidation commencing 1 Sep 2020**, with Christopher Herron listed as practitioner on the Companies House insolvency page.
- In **Bernhards Sport Surfaces Ltd v Astrosoccer 4 U Ltd** (8 Sep 2017; [2017] EWHC 2425 (TCC)), commentary reports Mr Justice Coulson criticised the misuse of insolvency threats and described “the connivance of Keystone Law”.

WFC-related disturbance (summary allegation)

- WFC is an unincorporated entity; the issue is alleged misdirection/authority confusion around who could speak for WFC and who the trustees were.
- It is alleged that an attempted winding-up strategy and continuing recovery assertions against “WFC” were pursued on incorrect authority assumptions, prolonging disruption to creditors and delaying closure of the Astrosoccer insolvency.

Impact alleged by IRAMA PTE LTD / Ian Rush MBE (summary)

- IRAMA PTE LTD (creditor) alleges prolonged insolvency disruption has contributed to substantial commercial and litigation harm, including harm to its partner **Mr Ian Rush MBE**.
