CASE STUDY

Irwin Mitchell — A Junior Solicitor's Story

In January 2025, a junior solicitor at Irwin Mitchell — one of the UK's largest national law firms — was struck off after admitting misconduct. But behind the ruling lay something far more alarming.

Rachael Worthington described being *bullied*, threatened with redundancy for failing billing targets, working **18-hour days, seven days a week**, and being called about a work query *while she was in labour*. She told the Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal that the pressure had led to **"serious mental health issues and being suicidal."**

Irwin Mitchell declined to comment.
